# **Mathematics Standard 1**

- Optional ATAR and HSC exam
- 5.1 level Classes 10M6/7
- currently 8 students in Year 11 (11 in Year 12)

# **Mathematics Standard 2** (ATAR)

• 5.2 or lower end of 5.3 level

• 10M2/3/4/5

• currently 70 in Year 11 (73 in Year 12)

• This is our most popular course

# Mathematics 2 unit ATAR

- 5.3 level Middle and top group
- 10M1 and top of 10M2
- currently 36 in Year 11 (27 in Year 12)

## Mathematics Extension 1 (1 Unit course) ATAR

- Top of 5.3 level 10M1
- currently 14 students in Year 11 (8 in Year 12)

## **Mathematics Extension 2 ATAR**

- offered in Year 12 only
- currently 2 students

## **Scaling of marks and ATARs**

- If you are planning on doing a university degree in Science, Medicine, Engineering or Mathematics you should study Mathematics Advanced.
- Bridging courses in Maths have high rates of attrition and add time and expense.
- Common grading across Mathematics Standard and Mathematics Advanced from 2019 means previous advice on Scaling is no longer relevant.

Please be guided by your Mathematics teachers recommendations.

It can be difficult to change courses during the year without changing several other subjects as well.
