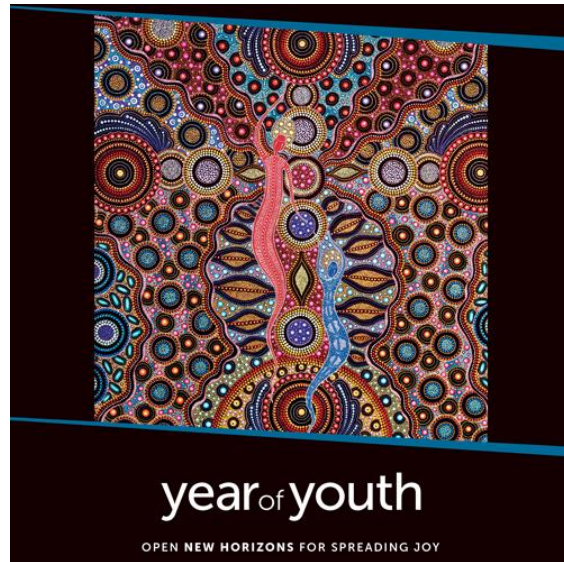



# Mandatory Subjects

- ▶ Religion

- ▶ Australian History and Geography
- ▶ Careers (Year 10 Only)

# Elective Subjects

- ▶ 2 Courses must be studied from Creative Arts & Languages/PDHPE/TAS/HSIE
- ▶ Each Course = 200 hours
- ▶ Each course will be of 2 years duration.
- ▶ Subjects are offered across the breadth of the Key Learning Areas.
- ▶ Refer to booklets for details and ask teachers for further advice to make informed decisions.

# Record of School Achievement

## RoSA

The RoSA shows a student's comprehensive record of academic achievement, which includes:

- ▶ completed courses and the awarded grade or mark
- ▶ courses a student has participated in but did not complete before leaving school
- ▶ results of any minimum standard literacy and numeracy tests that may have been sat
- ▶ Stage 5 (Year 10) and Preliminary Stage 6 (Year 11) courses, the student has satisfactorily completed.



# Satisfactory Completion of Course Requirements

- ▶ Follow approved course
- ▶ Apply yourself with **diligence** and **sustained effort** to the set tasks and experiences provided in the course.
- ▶ Achieve some or all of the course outcomes.

- ▶ Satisfactory completion includes such things as:
- ▶ attendance pattern
- ▶ level of involvement in class
- ▶ effort
- ▶ assignments
- ▶ homework completed
- ▶ and level of achievement



# Unsatisfactory Course Completion

If a student is in danger of not completing a course:

- ▶ A written warning will be given
- ▶ Opportunity will be given to correct any problem, or make up outstanding work.
- ▶ If no improvement occurs an “N” determination will be awarded.
- ▶ ‘N’ Determinations will have a serious impact on qualification for the Record of Student Achievement (ROSA).

# NAPLAN 2019

- ▶ The National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) assesses the literacy and numeracy skills of students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9, in schools across Australia.
- ▶ NAPLAN assesses writing, language conventions, reading and numeracy.
- ▶ In 2019 NAPLAN tests will be online
- ▶ NAPLAN results will help you understand how your child is progressing through school.

There will be multiple opportunities to pass online reading, writing and numeracy tests before and after the HSC





Early identification and support for students most at risk of not achieving the minimum standard is available under the NSW Literacy and Numeracy Strategy

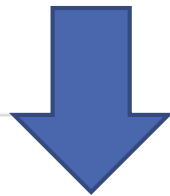
