Form Factor:	Laptop, Tablet or convertible device A tablet must have a physical keyboard attached.

Storage:	128GB or higher Solid State Drive (SSD) is highly recommended

Software:	Microsoft Office 365 Is available to all students free of charge Microsoft Security Essentials is an antivirus software that is built into Windows 10 and suitable for all devices
Case:	Students are required to have a robust protective hard case, sleeve or bag for their device.

Additional Considerations

Portable & Lightweight	1.6kg device weight is recommended Keep it light on their back and consider what your child can carry
Warranty & Insurance	2 Years is a standard warranty period for most devices The College strongly recommends students have adequate insurance (accidental damage) protection.
