Plan for staggered student face to face return to the College - Week 3-5 Term 2 - 2020

Students will return to face to face lessons based on the timetable set out below. Year 12 will be at the College every day, Year 11 two days and Years 7 - 10 one day per week. This plan will be reviewed in conjunction with the Catholic Schools Office and the Government medical advice after three weeks.

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Notes:

- Parents are asked to keep students at home where possible except for the day(s) their child is rostered to be at school.
- Siblings and other students who need to be at school will be supervised and they will
 continue learning using the online platforms.
- If students will be onsite, on any of their non-rostered days, parents are asked to contact the school on admin@booragul.catholic.edu.au 48 hours prior to that day so that appropriate supervision can be organised. This includes siblings of students who are rostered to be onsite. If the decision is made to have your child onsite every day, one email to cover weeks 3, 4 & 5 outlining your intentions will be sufficient. If that is the case, we ask that you notify the College if your child is then absent when they would normally be at school.

- Staff will continue to deliver online lessons for their classes when that class is not in attendance at the College. On the days that the class is at the College, online delivery will not be sent. Students who remain at home on their day will use that time for catching up missed work and other private study.
- Normal school Uniform rules apply.
- Normal school policies will apply.
- Classes will take place in timetabled rooms.
- Practical lessons (eg. Science, PDHPE, TAS) will continue using social distancing protocols if necessary. (Given that the Government medical advice is that schools are safe, this is not necessarily a consideration – but in PE it can be assumed that no contact style practical drills and games will happen.)
- We will use the Wednesday bell times so that there will be a CARE group lesson for each year group when they are on site. Year 12 will have recess in the normal CARE group slot and will have their CARE group time at recess This helps stagger the queue at the canteen in the first break.
- There will be some small changes to Year 7 and Year 9 timetables to allow for each KLA to be represented in the fortnight. For Year 7 on Friday, as there will be no sport, extra timetabled lessons will occur.
- Hand Sanitiser will be assigned to every teacher so that hands can be treated at the
 beginning of every lesson as students enter the room. Students are encouraged to
 also bring their own sanitiser.
- Cleaning products will be available in each room so that each student cleans their desk/chair at the end of the lesson. (Paper towel will also be supplied)
- Year 12 will use Holland Court only the other year group in attendance will be accommodated in the main yard.
- When Year 11 are here with Year 8, Year 11 will have the area in front of the Damascus Centre and Moncrief Shelter and Year 8 will be restricted to shade cloth and area outside of the hall, Music Classes (C Block) and Hall if wet.
- The Oval will open for appropriate recreation no contact sports (eg touch football, soccer etc Basketball Courts and Cage for hand ball only.)
- Canteen will be open markers for social distancing will be put down and staggering of student groups organised.
- There will be multiple reminder posters around the school about social distancing and hands off.
- Parent must ensure that students are kept at home if they have any respiratory style illness or symptoms (runny nose, cough etc) and that if students develop the same at school, parents will need to come and collect them ASAP.
