## HARDWARE SPECIFICATIONS:

Your Bring Your Own Device must meet the following requirements:

<b>Form Factor:</b>	Laptop, Tablet or convertible device A tablet must have a physical keyboard attached.
<b>Screen Size:</b>	11.6-inch to 14-inch screen size

<b>CPU:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Intel Core i5 or i7</li><li>• AMD Ryzen 5 (and above)</li></ul>
<b>Storage:</b>	128GB or higher Solid-State Hard Drive (SSD)
<b>Memory:</b>	8 - 16 GB RAM
<b>Wireless:</b>	802.11n, 802.11ac 5Ghz are supported
<b>Battery:</b>	8 to 12 hours The battery life should last the whole school day but will vary depending on usage.
<b>Software:</b>  <i><b>Important - please read</b></i>	<p><b>Microsoft Office 365 Professional</b> is available <u>free of charge</u> to all students via the MNConnect website</p> <p><b>Microsoft Security Essentials (anti-virus)</b> is built into Windows 10/11 and is a suitable antivirus program</p>
<b>Protective Case:</b>	It is highly recommended for students to have a robust protective hard case, sleeve or bag for their device.

## Additional Considerations:

<b>Portable &amp; Lightweight</b>	MAX 1.5kg device weight is recommended Keep it light on their back and consider what your child can carry
<b>Warranty &amp; Insurance</b>	3 Years warranty is recommended for devices The College strongly recommends students have Accidental Damage protection.
