Bring Your Own Device

The BYOD model provides choice and flexibility for our students. All students are expected to bring their own computing device to school every day. The school makes recommendations as to the device specifications that your laptop or tablet will need.

Windows 10 & 11 in S mode

Most retailers are selling laptops with Windows 10 or 11 in S mode as the preinstalled operating system. The OS is locked down to a state where the user is unable to install any programs.

This version of Windows is not supported with our BYOD program. However, you can choose to switch out of S mode at no extra charge. If you need assistance, please see IT support in the Student Hub.

Warranty & Accidental Damage Protection

Most devices will include a 2years standard warranty period which will cover any hardware defects. It does not cover broken screens, broken cases from being dropped or if liquid is spilt on the device.

Retailers can provide an extended warranty period and/or accidental damage protection as an additional cost at the time of purchasing your device.

Android, IOS, Linux and Chromebook operating systems are not supported with our BYOD program. Our school supports the Microsoft Windows environment and programs designed to run on Windows 10 & 11 OS.
